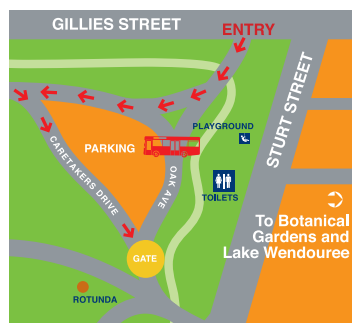

FREE PARK & RIDE
